## 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> year Dual Credential Courses

During the second and third year of the dual credential, there are between 2-3 RESP courses in a semester. The remaining courses that can be taken towards the BHSc are outlined in <u>Bachelor of Health Science</u>. All students must make an appointment with the RT Department Chairperson for advising on their non-RESP courses. After this has occurred, the non-RESP courses taken towards the BHSc must be approved by the TRU-OL program advisor to ensure they are appropriate for the program and/or to meet future educational goals.

The BHSc degree that is part of the dual credential is awarded through TRU-OL, and therefore, students enrolled in this option, must complete and submit a <a href="https://example.com/Program Admission/Transfer Credit form">Program Admission/Transfer Credit form</a>. Applicants are required to provide official documentation showing their full post-secondary academic history.
