Wash hands.														
Assemble equipment prior to venipuncture.														
Ensure correct patient identification.														
Ensure patient is in a safe and accessible position.														
Put on gloves.														
Select the appropriate venipuncture site.														
Cleanse site, using appropriate disinfectant and technique.														
Apply tourniquet correctly.														
Perform venipuncture, including:														
• Anchoring the vein.														
• Smooth and quick insertion of the needle.														
• Stillness of the needle in the patient's arm.														
• Prompt and appropriate mixing of specimen.														
• Release of the tourniquet prior to needle removal.														
• Application of pressure to the puncture site with a clean gauze or cotton swab.														
Dispose of waste materials (including needles) properly.														
Perform multiple draws.
