



The Faculty of Medicine at UBC offers a four-year medical education program leading to a Doctor of Medicine (MD). All students must meet the academic and other standards set by the Faculty of Medicine and will graduate with a UBC degree. **328** students are selected each cycle and will be distributed across the province within four training sites:

Students planning to apply for admission to the Doctor of Medicine program at UBC should select courses that satisfy the requirements of a Bachelor's degree of their choice along with the courses needed to qualify for admission. Diploma and certificate courses are usually not counted towards the program requirements and students should reach out to the UBC MD Undergraduate admissions team for clarification if they are not sure about a specific program. Consideration will be given to students from a variety of backgrounds, and no particular degree program is considered ideal for the study and practice of medicine. As admission to UBC Medicine is extremely competitive, students should plan for an alternative career option.

A minimum of 90 university-transferable credits with grades taken at a post-secondary institution is required. (AP, IB and A Level credit do not count towards the 90 minimum credits).
